Internally, the home features a well-proportioned kitchen and a spacious living room enhanced by a bay window that floods the space with natural light, along with a feature fireplace.

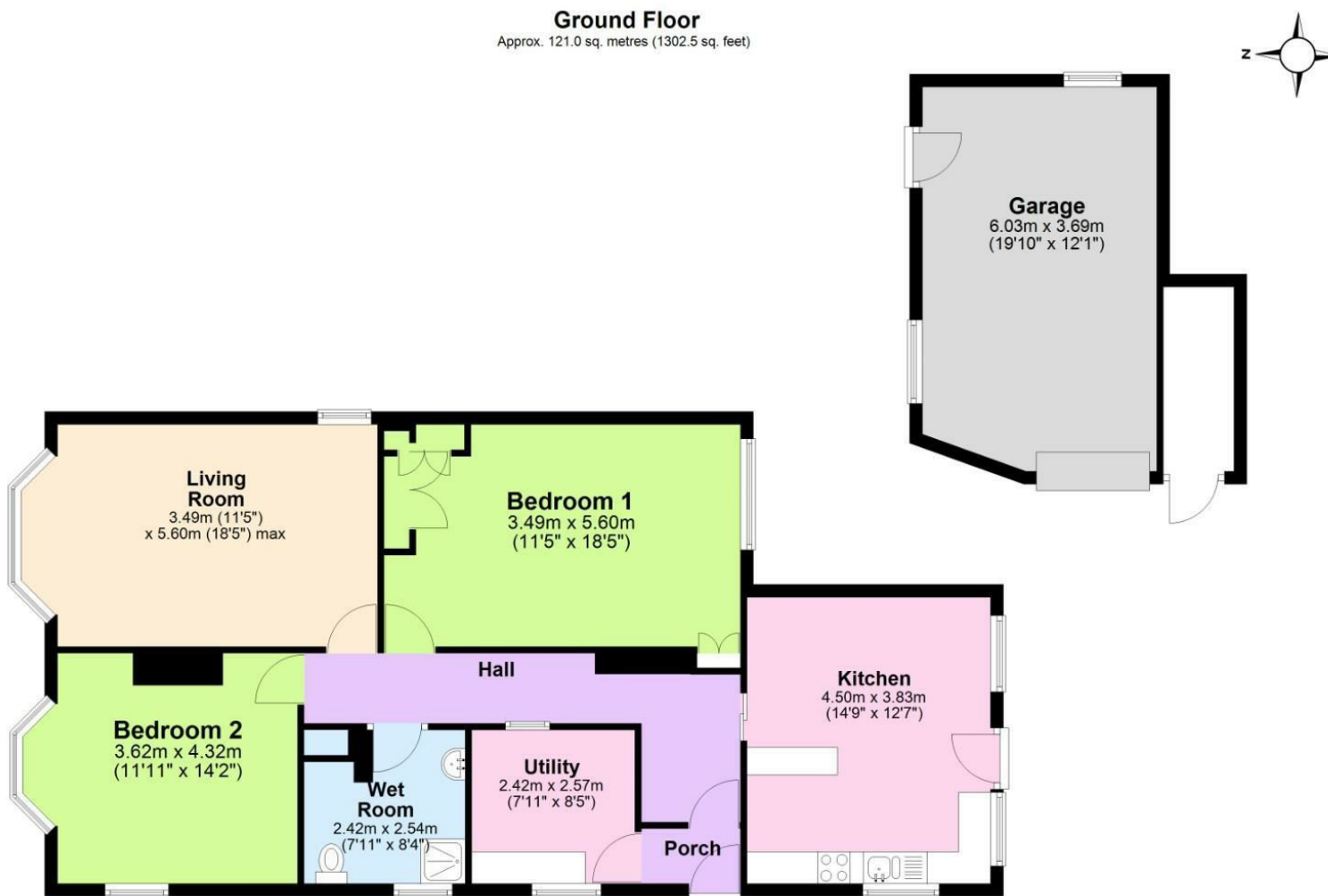
