Internal accommodation comprises an entrance hallway off which internal doors lead to a lounge and separate kitchen. To the first floor there are two generous double bedrooms, a smaller third bedroom and a family bathroom comprising a three piece suite.

To the front of the property a driveway offers ample off-street parking for multiple vehicles with an enclosed rear garden accessed from a side passage or from the kitchen or the dining room.
