A standout feature of this space is the multi-fuel effect gas fire, beautifully set within a Lakeland stone-effect inglenook, adding warmth and character. The wooden-effect flooring complements the rustic charm, while a set of curved stairs leads gracefully to the upper floors.

To the rear of the ground floor is the kitchen, fitted with stylish sage green shaker-style base and wall units, offering ample storage and a classic aesthetic. It is equipped with a five-ring gas hob and oven, an overhead extractor fan, integrated washing machine and fridge-freezer. Finished with modern tiling and a wooden floor. A traditional barn door opens directly out to the property's private parking space for added convenience, which could also be used as a patio area to the side, with a storage area to the rear.

Across the first and second floors, the accommodation includes a spacious master bedroom with an en-suite shower room, two further well-proportioned bedrooms, and a beautifully presented family bathroom. The bathroom features a roll-top bath and a separate shower cubicle, combining traditional elegance with modern functionality to complete this charming and unique cottage.

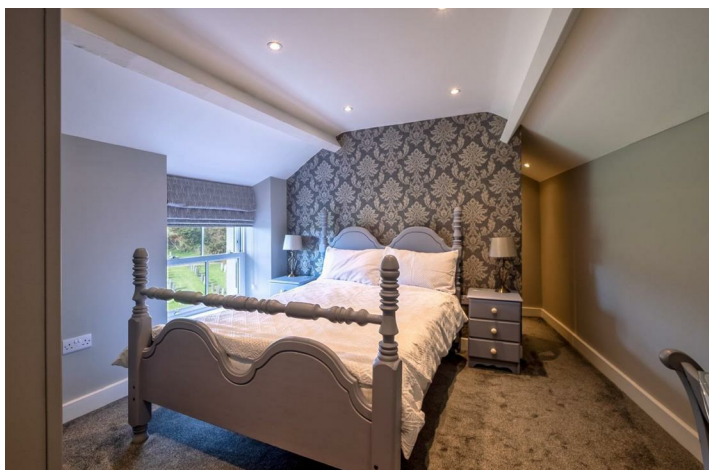

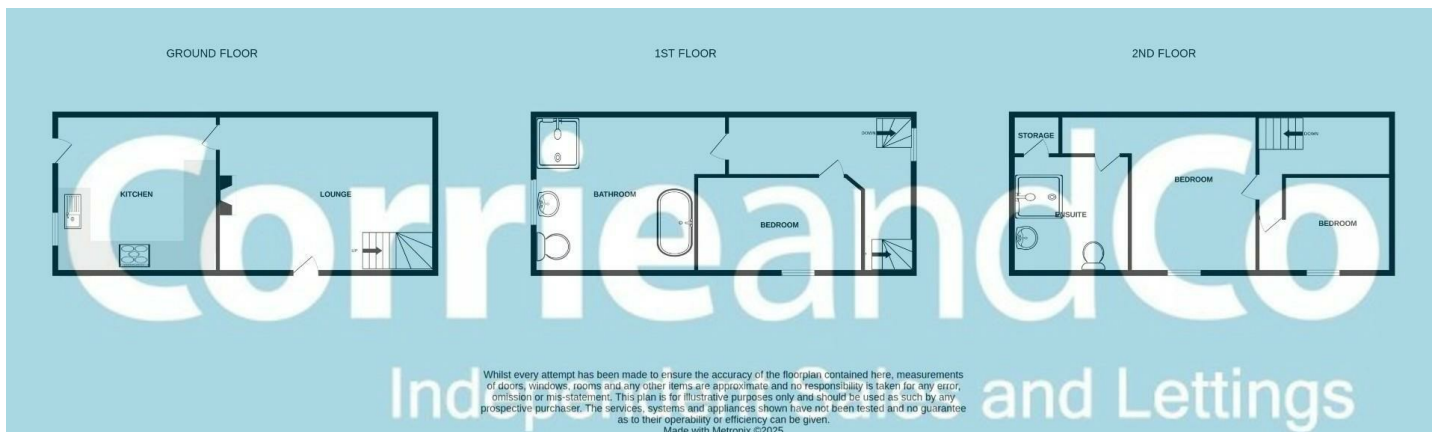
Road Map
