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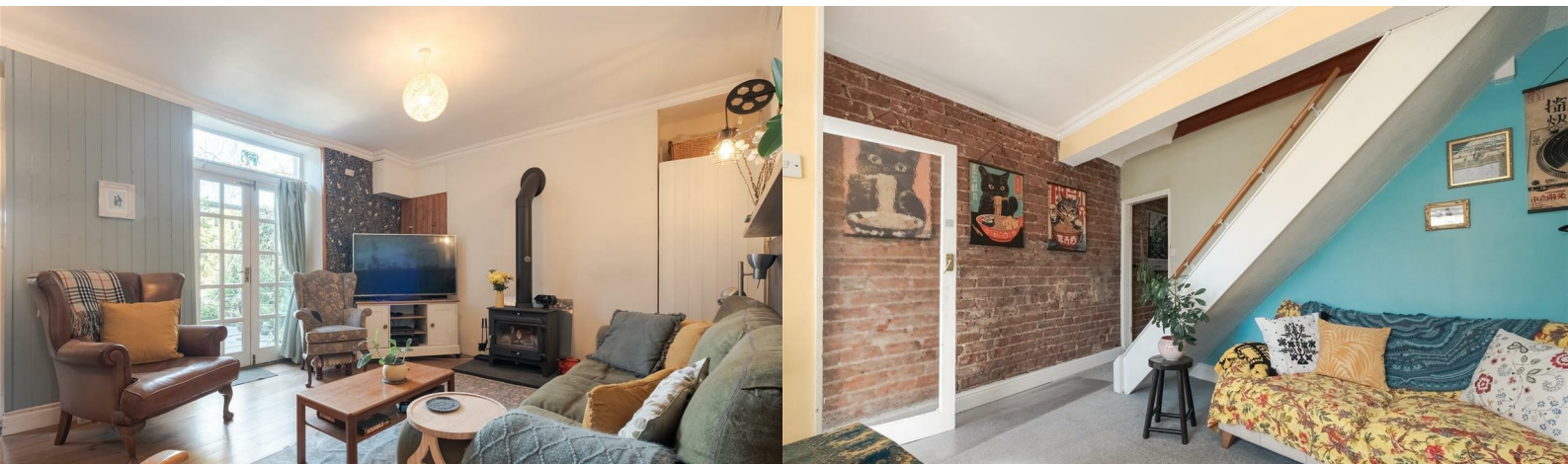
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Nestled in the charming town of Dalton-In-Furness, this delightful terraced house offers a perfect blend of historical character and modern living. Built around 1850, the property boasts a rich heritage while providing ample space for a growing family or those seeking a comfortable home. Upon entering the property you step into a small vestibule perfect for kicking off muddy shoes and hanging wet coats. The vestibule opens straight into the dining room featuring an open staircase and exposed red brick. Moving through the house into the lounge, the exposed brick work ties the two rooms together whilst a large log burner sits in the centre as a feature piece, double doors open into the rear yard. The kitchen is located at the rear of the property and offers ample cupboard and worktop space.

On the first floor, located at the rear of the property is the large bathroom featuring extra cupboard storage space for towels. As well as one of the bedrooms with a further bedroom located to the front of the home. Climbing another staircase to the top of the property we have another two bedrooms. The bedroom at the rear features an ensuite WC.

A private ginnel allows access to the side of the property and can be entered from the front street and the kitchen. Lastly, the well established courtyard garden offers space to enjoy the outside and the chance to enjoy some fresh air.

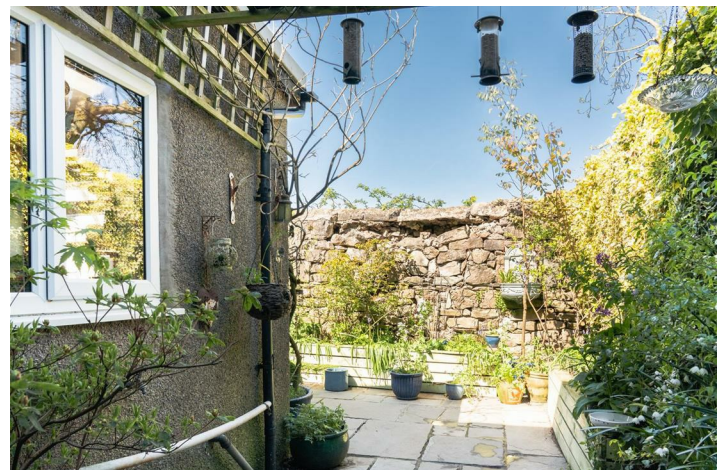
