












EXTENDED VICTORIAN ARCHITECTURE WITH LAWNED REAR GARDENS! A delightful Victorian cottage ideally located on Oakfield Terrace, within Gosforth's conservation area. Originally constructed circa 1850, Oakfield Terrace is unique to Newcastle being the only street to offer Sunderland Cottages in the city. Close to the shops of Ashburton Road, the location also gives easy access to Gosforth High Street and its countless great shops, restaurants and cafés.

Boasting in excess of 1,250 Sq. ft the accommodation briefly comprises entrance hall through to an impressive 27ft principal reception with dual aspect, tall ceilings and period fireplace; an extended breakfasting kitchen with vaulted ceiling and Velux roof lights which opens to a dining room with picture French windows overlooking the rear garden; refitted shower, master bedroom and family bathroom to the ground floor. Extended into the original roof space, the first floor boasts two double bedrooms. Externally, with a town garden to the front, a shared block paved driveway give access to a generous rear garden laid mainly to lawn with block paved hard standing and detached garage with electric up and over door. Well presented throughout this great family home demands an early internal inspection!


