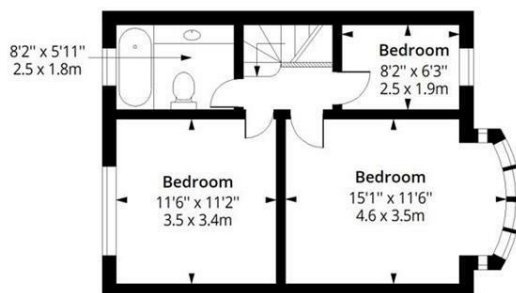
Upstairs are three well-proportioned bedrooms along with the family bathroom, providing a straightforward layout that works well for families and those looking for a little extra space.

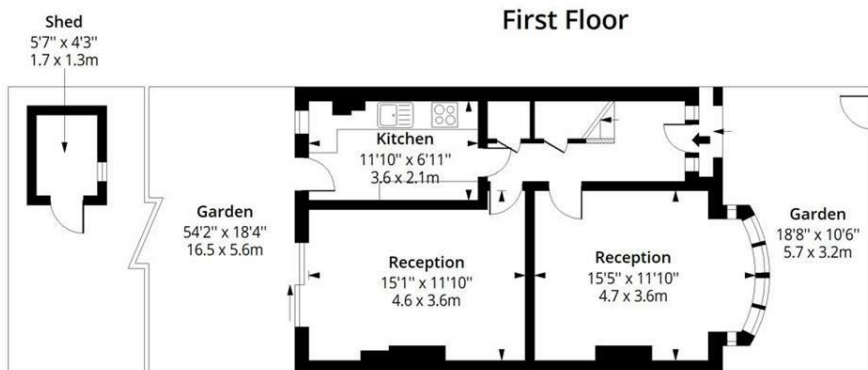
There is plenty to like about the property as it stands, but equally, it offers an exciting opportunity for someone looking to modernise and create a home tailored to their own taste and requirements.
