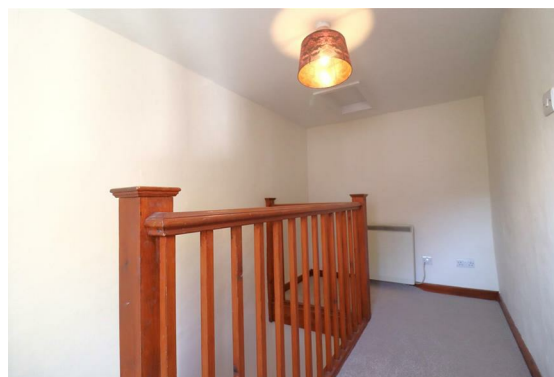
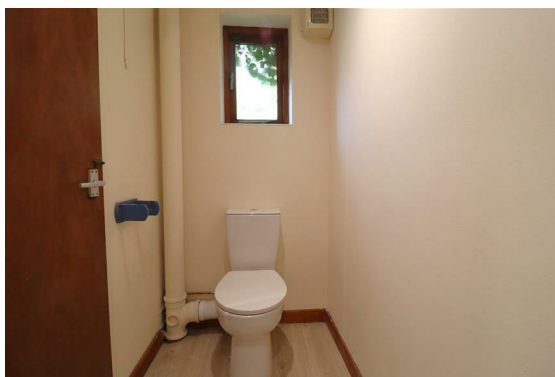
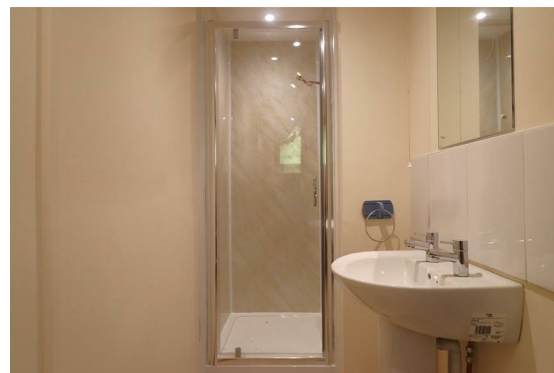
LOCATION

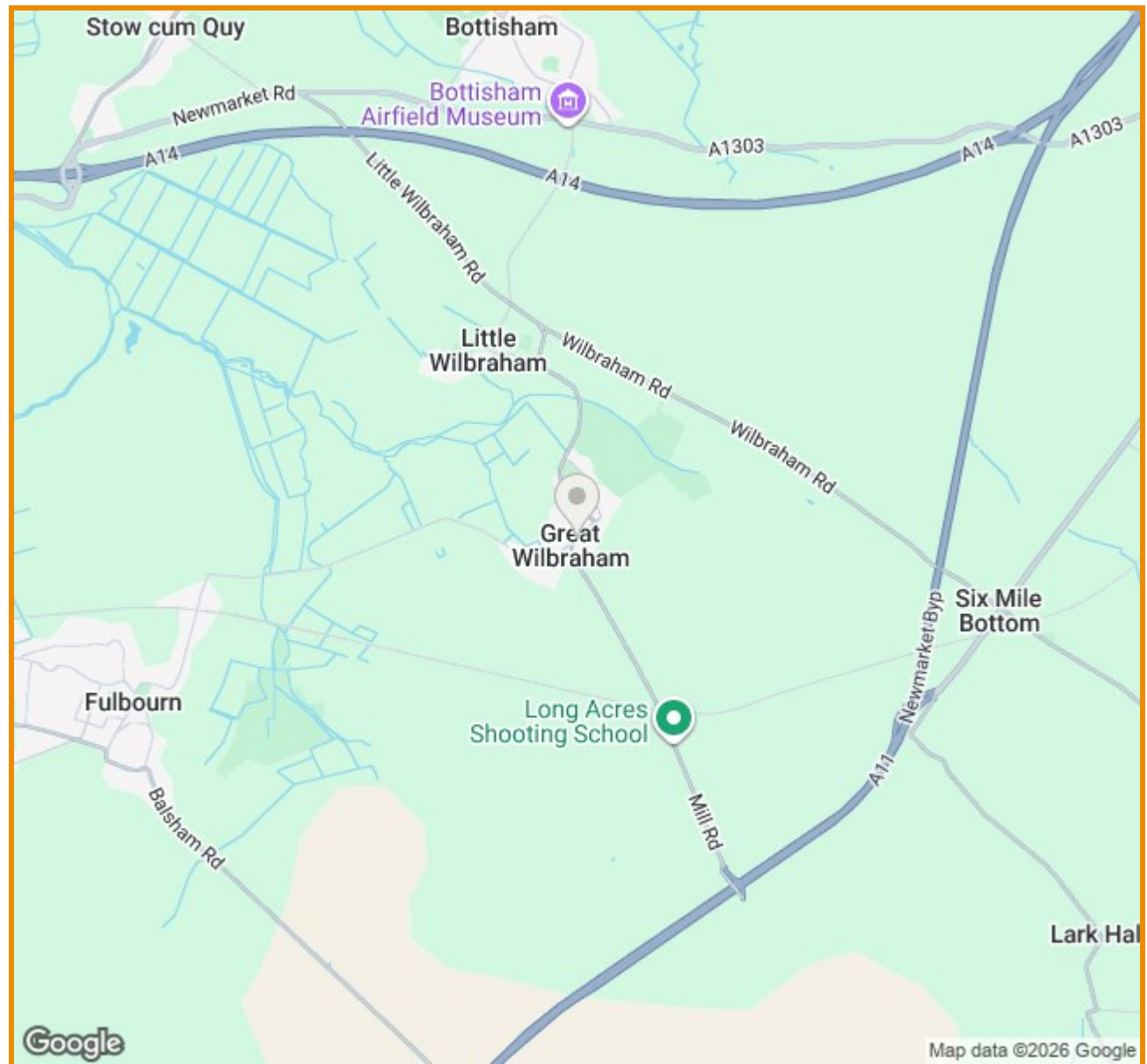
