Upon reaching the village square turn left onto the A525 Woore Road, continue along Woore Road to the village of Buerton. Turn left into Windmill Lane and right into Vernon Drive, bear right into Schoolfield Close where the property will be observed on the left hand side.

BUERTON & AUDLEM VILLAGE

Buerton is a village about 7 miles south of Nantwich and 1.5 miles easts of the village of Audlem, on the border of Cheshire & Shropshire.

Nearby villages also include:- Adderley, Bridgemere, Hankelow, Hatherton, Hunsterson & Woore. Buerton Primary School in Buerton village closed in 2006. the parish falls within the catchment areas of Audlem St James C E Primary School in Audlem & Brine Leas High School in Nantwich.

Audlem is an attractive, extremely well serviced award-winning country village, the centre of which is designated as a Conservation Area, well known for its Church dating back to 1279. Audlem has a medical practice, chemist, primary school, play group, three public houses and a range of

shops. It is also the location of 15 locks on the Shropshire Union Canal.
