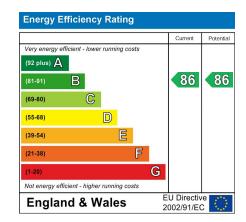

Built just four years ago, this stunning penthouse apartment has a southfacing covered balcony and is in an exceptionally convenient location.

A discreet private entrance leads to the lift which smoothly arrives at this second floor apartment.

Polished oak flooring stretches from the light and bright hallway and into the triple aspect sitting room with sleek fitted kitchen cabinets and dining area. The south facing private balcony has porcelain flooring and enjoys the sun throughout the day.

There are three well-proportioned bedrooms and two bathrooms, one a recently re-fitted en-suite shower room. There are plenty of storage cupboards and, downstairs, a bike store.

Secured behind a barrier, is the parking space (G), tucked away at the end of the row. Entry is via a fob.
